Jim and Nanc Skaret have been residents of Bismarck since 1978. They raised two boys in Bismarck. Their oldest son and daughter in law and their only grandchild live in Bismarck. Jim is a Civil Engineer by profession and Nanc is a Dental Assistant by profession. They met in the Twin Cities area when Jim was about to graduate from the University of Minnesota. They were married in December 1968 shortly after Jim began a 3 year tour of duty in the US Army. Both are now retired and enjoy spending a portion of their winter in Arizona.

Jim and Nanc have been members of the Sons of Norway since 2003. Jim is a Tronder with both his grandmother and grandfather on his father's side of the family having emigrated from the Trondheim area of Norway around 1900. Jim grew up in Fargo near the neighborhood where his father was born and raised by his Norwegian parents and near some of his father's relatives of Norwegian descent.

Nanc is a Telemarker, with her great grandfather and great grandmother on her father's side emigrating from the town of Hoydalsmo in the province of Telemark. Nanc grew up on a farm near Delevan, MN, less than ½ mile from the original family farmstead built by her great grandfather in the 1860's.
