First let's talk about Duane. Two important things happened on January 30, 1933; Adolf Hitler was made Chancellor of Germany and Duane Carlton Svanes was born in Kintyre, North Dakota to Carl and Myrtle (Farness) Svanes. Duane has lived his entire life, up to this time, within four miles of the place where he was born.

He attended elementary school in Kintyre, attended and graduated from high school at Oak Grove in Fargo.

He has one brother Harold who was for years a partner in family farming operations. Upon Harold's retirement and moving from the farm, Duane's sons Dana and Alan have taken over the operations of the farm. Duane continues to assist in the farming operations as well as operating the Svanes Hunting Lodge, located on the yard of his current home with wife Shirley.

Duane was married to Frances Peterson and they had four children – Dana and Alan who live nearby and have a grain and cattle operation at Kintyre. Dennis is a C.P.A. and works for a Rural Electric Cooperative at Durango, Colorado. Daughter Diana and husband Randy live at Bismarck. Dana teaches at Fort Lincoln Elementary at Mandan. Duane is Papa to thirteen grandchildren.

Community involvement includes serving as church treasurer, participation in the board of South Central Grain, and has served as District 28 Republican Precinct Chairman.

Duane enjoys traveling and has visited Norway 10 times, beginning at the age of four. He enjoys hosting relatives from Norway and sharing with them hospitality and touring of our country. He has stayed in close contact with 13 first cousins in Norway, many of whom have now passed. He also has visited several Asian countries, Mexico, Caribbean Islands, Europe and Scandinavian countries. He has toured in 46 of the United States including Hawaii and Alaska.

His Sverdrup Sons of Norway involvements include membership since 1968 and a Golden Member since 1998. She grew up on the farm, attended country school and graduated from Pelican Rapids High School. She attended Concordia College for one year, worked as a secretary and returned to college and obtained a degree in Home Economics Education at North Dakota State University.

She married James McMaster at New Town and was mother to two sons, Mark and Joel. Her husband Jim and son Mark died from cancer in 1990 and 1991, respectively. Joel and Cathy are parents to her two grandchildren, Rian and Lindsey.

Her entire teaching career was spent at New Town High School – 22+ years. She also worked for a time at the Fort Berthold Extension Service. Upon early retirement from teaching and with a home economics background, she was employed as dietary supervisor at the New Town Nursing Home.
